RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CARTER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT, INITIATING THE REFINANCING PROCESS IN ORDER TO REFUND AND RETIRE SCHOOL BUILDING REVENUE BONDS (SERIES 2011) ORIGINALLY ISSUED TO FINANCE THE PROJECT; CONFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN OFFER OF ASSISTANCE FROM THE KENTUCKY SCHOOL FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT WITH SAID COMMISSION; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT, LEASE AND OPTION WITH THE CARTER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT FINANCE CORPORATION AND ANY FURTHER NECESSARY INSTRUMENTS; AND APPROVING THE PLAN OF REFINANCING SAID PROJECT GENERALLY.

3. Adopt Resolution Authorizing the Advanced Revenue Refund Bonds

A motion was made by Rachel Fankell and seconded by Kirk Wilburn to call the meeting of the Carter County School District Finance Corporation to order at 6:35 P.M., to confirm the officers of the corporation as being the same officers as the Carter County Board of Education, and to adopt the following resolution:

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CARTER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT FINANCE CORPORATION, RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$8,920,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT (SUBJECT TO A PERMITTED ADJUSTMENT OF \$890,000) OF SCHOOL BUILDING REFUNDING REVENUE BONDS SERIES OF 2017 (THE REFUNDING BONDS) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 58.180 AND 162.120 THROUGH 162.290 AND 162.385 OF THE KENTUCKY REVISED STATUTES FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING AT OR PRIOR TO THEIR RESPECTIVE MATURITIES THE OUTSTANDING CARTER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT FINANCE CORPORATIN SCHOOL BUILDING REVENUE BONDS, SERIES OF 2011, DATED JANUARY 1, 2011 (THE PRIOR ISSUE) THROUGH THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT IN THE ESCROW FUND OF THE NET PROCEEDS OF THE RUFUNDING BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF CERTAIN FUNDS TO EFFECT THE DEFEASEMENT OF THE RIGHTS OF THE REGISTERED OWNERS OF THE BONDS OF THE PRIOR ISSUE AND THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN AMOUNTS INTO CERTAIN FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR THE RIGHTS OF THE REGISTERED OWNERS OF SAID REFUNDING BONDS AND THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN ADVERTISED PUBLIC COMPETITIVE SALE OF SAID REFUNDING BONDS.

The motion carried with a unanimous vote of 4 to 0.
