A Growth Mindset

In 2006, Stanford psychology professor, Carol Dweck, introduced the idea of two mindsets related to learning: Growth and Fixed. If you have a Growth Mindset, your belief system suggests that a person's intelligence can be grown with persistence, effort, and a focus on learning. A person with a **Fixed** Mindset is of the belief system that one has a predetermined amount

of intelligence, skills, or talents. Dweck asserted that our mindsets affect the way we teach our students, raise our children, and even behave in learning situations ourselves.

Spotlight on Excellence

"1...2...3...Showdown!" Students in Sarah Knipp's Kindergarten class at Prichard loved using this Kagan strategy in a small group with their instructional assistant to review the consonant-vowel-consonant pattern and letter sounds. Using a strategy like *showdown* keeps all students engaged, gives them a chance to revise their work with peer guidance, and allows the teacher/assistant to see every child's work when they show their boards.
